## Lady Bandits Fast Pitch Softball Fund Raising Guidelines

The following guidelines apply to any and all teams that are part of the Lady Bandits Fast Pitch Softball organization. Any special requests must be approved by the board.

- 1. All fundraising events/promotions must be approved by the President of the board.
- 2. Money raised for the team, which are not set up as revenue split will be deposited in the team's general account. This will be net after costs involved. "Revenue split" is deemed as funds earned according to amount of revenue collected/earned by the player individually.
- 3. Money raised which is to be revenue split must be logged into a ledger so that each player that participated knows how much they have for future travel etc. These funds will be distributed no later than 5 days prior to the tournament requiring travel. The Treasurer of the Lady Bandits Fast Pitch Softball organization will keep a team ledger. Players will receive a monthly statement of their individual account on or before the 20th of each month.
- 4. Players that do not participate in revenue split fundraisers are not eligible to receive funds from said fundraiser.
- 5. Door to Door fund raising is prohibited. Any team violating this guideline will be subject to a formal review from the board.
- 6. Any funds raised by a player through a revenue split will be forfeited and applied to the organizations general account if the player leaves or is released from their respective team within the organization.
